What's a "Mock Trial" and why would I want to participate?

Our goal for this event is to give new teams the chance to experience an official agility trial atmosphere, with all the usual procedures like timed walk throughs, run orders, ring crew, judges, measuring, etc.

Just like a real trial, we'll have a briefing, then walk throughs, then competitors will go into the ring in the order posted on the gate sheets, arranged by height.

We will run the same course twice, running all dogs in Round 1 then immediately starting over again for Round 2.

A judge will supervise your run, a leash runner will take your leash from start to finish, and there will be ring crew sitting around the sides of the course waiting to set bars and adjust tunnels, etc.

Each team will have 60 seconds to spend in the ring, from entering to exiting. We will have a timer keeping track.

Although you can run your dog at whatever height you prefer, we will have wickets and a measuring device to get an unofficial measurement of your dog's height.

At this event, you can bring a toy into the ring to train with, but no food will be allowed in the ring, just like a real trial.

Toys can be thrown as long as you can get them back in a timely manner. They should not make noise or have pieces that can fall off. No food in the toys.

Crating available:

Crating indoors, climate controlled
Please bring a mat to place your crate on
Plenty of parking close to the building to crate out of the car if preferred.

Confirmations:

A Final confirmation of your entry will be sent out by email the weekend before the fun match date, with more information.

Volunteer info:

Many hands make light work! We will have an experienced staff of volunteer workers to help run the event, but if you'd like to learn how to do certain jobs, we'll be happy to teach you! Please pitch in where you can- it's part of the great agility trial experience.

How do I know my dog's "height at the withers?"

The height of a dog is the measurement of a perpendicular line from a flat surface on the ground to the highest point of the dog's shoulders. This point is at the top of the shoulders where the neck appears to meet the shoulders.

When performing the measurement, the dog's legs should be directly underneath, and the dog should not be leaning forward or backward. The dog's head should be in a natural state and not be lowered downward.

You can get a rough idea of your dog's height by standing them next to a wall and making a pencil mark at that highest shoulder point. Then measure from the floor to that mark. Remember not to include fluffy fur in your measurement! You'll want to feel for the shoulder blades.

AGREEMENT

The person who signs this agreement represents that he/she is authorized to enter into this agreement on behalf of both exhibitor and the owner of entered dog. In consideration of acceptance of this entry:

1.1. As used here "PDS" means Premier Dog Sports, its members, officers, directors, employees, show chairs, show committees and agents.

1.2. Exhibitor/owner agree to abide by the rules and regulations set forth by PDS and the event coordinators and any other rules and regulations appearing in the premium for this event.

1.3. Exhibitor/owner certify that the entered dog is not a hazard to persons, dogs or property and that the entered dog's rabies vaccination is current in accordance with the requirement of the state in which the dog resides.

1.4. Exhibitor/owner acknowledge all hazards presented by the event and the event premises, including, but not limited to, the condition of the surface, restrooms, security measures or lack of, electrical appliances, fittings, show rings, parking areas and the presence of unfamiliar animals and people; exhibitor and owner assume the risk of any harm arising from these.

1.5. Exhibitor/owner releases PDS (including its respective officers, directors, employees, and members), Up and Over Dog Sports (including its officers, directors, members, and event organizing committee), and will defend them and hold them harmless from all present and future loss, injury, damage, claims, demands and liabilities involving the entered dog, the event or event premises. Without limiting the generality of the foregoing hold harmless provisions, exhibitor/owner hereby specifically assumes sole responsibility for and agrees to indemnify and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expenses (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damages because of bodily injuries, including death, at any time in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, howsoever such injury or death may be caused and whether or not the same may have been caused or may have been alleged to have been caused by negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees or agents or any other persons.

1.6 No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reasons of riots, civil disturbances, fire, acts of God, public emergency, an act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.

1.7 Checks not honored by the bank do not constitute a valid entry fee. There will be a \$30.00 service charge for bank returned checks.
